

SUMMARY PASTIZAL & PICACHOS



LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Pastizal & Picachos project is located in the IV Region of Coquimbo, Northern Chile, approximately 30 minutes drive southeast from the city of Andacollo and near to the TECK mine Carmen de Andacollo (Cu, Au) and medium size mines (Tambillos district).







GEOCHEMICAL AND GEOPHYSICAL

Detailed **Geochemical sampling** at major targets and mines, including underground mines, using a portable XRF analyzer and preliminary laboratory results across the area.

Geophysical studies using the Induced Polarization (IP) method in the Picachos Project.



MINING PROPERTY

The mining concessions of **Pastizal and Picachos are** both fully and partially owned by COSEMÍN Ltda. These mining properties cover a total area of 600 hectares.





DRILLING AND TARGET SIZE

The common conclusion made by several geologist recommend further and deeper drilling to increased substantially the resources and mining potential.



ROCK CHIP AND MINERALIZATION

Copper-silver mineralization along regional faults influenced by Jurassic and Cretaceous rocks, forming vein-shaped and mantiform mineralized bodies within a hydrothermal alteration zone.





OPPORTUNITY

Convert the actual small size mining operation into medium size copper concentrate producer.
